### Whose Kingdom Come

**Matthew 6:10 Your kingdom come ... ESV**

**Matthew 6:10 May Your kingdom come soon ... NLT**

1. Question: What \_\_\_\_\_ is being referred to here when we pray that God's kingdom come?
2. The focus on God's kingdom brings three different thoughts:
  - a. The \_\_\_\_\_ already is in God's kingdom.
  - b. **"Your kingdom come"** also refers to the second coming when Christ sets up His eternal (\_\_\_\_\_) kingdom.
