John 19:38-42

All In

John 19:38 Afterward Joseph of Arimathea, who had been a secret disciple of Jesus (because he feared the Jewish leaders), asked Pilate for permission to take Jesus' body down. When Pilate gave him permission, he came and took the body away.

Matthew 27:57 As evening approached, Joseph, a rich man from Arimathea who was one of Jesus' followers,

Luke 23:50 Now there was a good and righteous man named Joseph. He was a member of the Jewish high council,⁵¹ but he had not agreed with the decision and actions of the other religious leaders. He was from the town of Arimathea in Judea, and he had been waiting for the Kingdom of God to come.

Mark 15:42 This all happened on Friday, the day of preparation, the day before the Sabbath. As evening approached,⁴³ an honored member of the high council, Joseph from Arimathea (who was waiting for the Kingdom of God to come), gathered his courage and went to Pilate to ask for Jesus' body.
